Earning our BSN increases your lifetime earning potential and serves as a gateway to more advanced opportunities. BSN holders can go on to earn their master's degree and become advanced practice nurse practitioners (APRNs).

Earn your BSN — On your time

With seven-week classes and six start dates per year, UB's RN to BSN program is designed to work for you. You can transfer up to 90 credits from an accredited RN program and complete the BSN program in just 30 credits — saving you time and money. Our online program can be completed on your schedule, allowing you to continue work as an RN as your earn your BSN.

Expand your knowledge

At UB, you'll engage in evidence-based training to expand your knowledge of nursing practices. Our curriculum focuses on growing your understanding of health assessment, safety, and community health. You'll gain hands-on training during your community practice experience, where you'll spend 35 hours completing a project that benefits your community.

- Complete the application for enrollment at bridgeport.edu/apply
- Current, unencumbered RN license in your state of residence
- Cumulative G.P.A of 2.5 or higher
- Transcripts from any colleges or universities attended
- Proof of high school completion or its equivalent
